## What we are learning during the Summer term in Year 6...

### English

We'll be linking our writing to WWII as we write non-chronological reports, narratives, news reports and a set of instructions linked to the classic movie 'The Great Escape'.

### Maths

We'll be finishing the last few units of White Rose as we look at shape, data and position and direction. We will be revising FDP as well as looking at some SATs style questions in the build up to SATs week.

### Science

In Science in the second half of the Summer term we will be looking at electricity. This proves to be a real hands-on experience for the children as they use a range of resources which we have in school.

### History

Our learning will be focused around WWII and the Holocaust. As part of our learning we will be visiting the National Holocaust Centre to see how life changed for groups of people during this time.

### Art

Our focus artist will be Romero Britto as we look at collages for the first time and as always, we will have the opportunity to create our own final piece of art.

### Design & Technology

Closely linked to our Science learning, we will be looking at electrical systems and how we can design, make and evaluate whilst using electrical circuits.

### Computing

We are currently following the Teach Computing scheme and we will be looking at coding and programming.

### Religious Education

Our RE work closely links to the Holocaust as we look at Kindertransport and how different people supported minority groups during this time period. We will also look at how the Jewish community were victimised and what we have learnt since.

### RESPECT

Our weekly circle time, DEIB assemblies and RSHE lessons will mean we are continuing to discuss current issues, talk about life after primary school and consider our role in the community.

### Music

As we continue to follow Sing Up, we will be looking at the Chariots of Fire and making our own compositions.

### PE

We will carry on playing badminton in the first half term, as well as playing cricket as we polish our striking and fielding knowledge. In the second half of the Summer term we will be looking at orienteering and we will also be lucky enough to have the swimming pool back on site for the Year 6 children for the last few weeks of the year.

### French

In French we are going to look at our family tree and pets.
