Sports Days 2026

I am writing to confirm the dates and times for this year's Sports Days. We look forward to welcoming families to celebrate and support the children as they take part in a range of sporting activities on the following dates:

- **Years 1 and 2:** Tuesday 16th June at 1.30pm (parents/carers to arrive from 1.15pm)
- **Years 3 and 4:** Wednesday 17th June at 1.30pm (parents/carers to arrive from 1.15pm)
- **Years 5 and 6:** Thursday 18th June at 1.30pm (parents/carers to arrive from 1.15pm)
- **Nursery:** Friday 19th June at 9.30am (parents/carers can take seats after morning drop off)
- **Reception:** Friday 19th June at 2pm (parents/carers to arrive from 1.45pm)

Nursery and Reception

Sports Day will take place on the school field. Nursery and Reception children will each take part in a number of races and activities, and parents and carers are warmly invited to attend and support them. Chairs will be placed on one side of the track for families, with the children seated opposite. Once Sports Day has finished, we kindly ask families to remain seated while the children wave and return to their classrooms. Once all children have left the field, families may safely leave the school grounds. Reception children should then be collected from their classroom doors at the end of the school day as normal.

Afternoon Nursery children are welcome to attend the morning Sports Day session on Friday 19th June. Children can be collected at 11.45am from the usual collection point. This will replace their usual afternoon Nursery session on that day.

Years 1–6

Sports Days for Years 1–6 will run in our usual format, with children taking part in a range of activities on a rotation. Points will be awarded to teams throughout the afternoon, with the overall winning team announced at the end and medals presented.

Parents and carers are welcome to attend and should arrive via the main entrance from **1.15pm onwards**, where they will be directed to the school field. Parents will be able to watch the activities from the perimeter of the sporting arena and move around the course to support their children.

Following the team events, there will also be running races for each year group. Years 1 and 2 will have boy and girl sprint races. Years 3 to 6 will have team relay races in addition to their sprint races.

These will be the final races, featuring children who qualified through heats held during PE lessons before Sports Day.

At the end of the afternoon, children will return to their classrooms and be dismissed in the usual way to ensure everyone leaves safely.

Parents and carers are welcome to take photographs and videos of their own child for personal use. We kindly ask that photographs and videos are not shared on social media.
