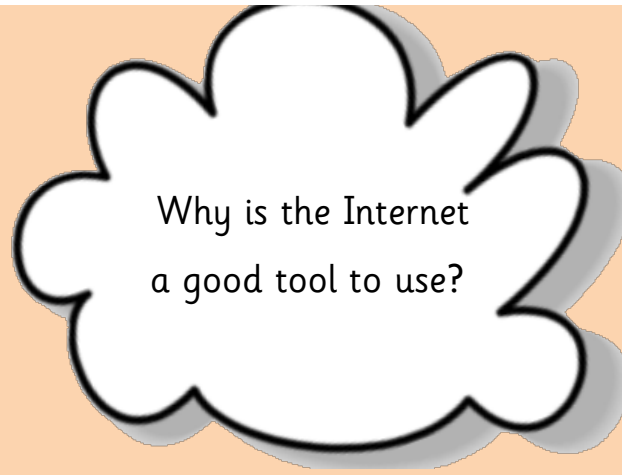

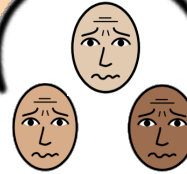

Jobs are for everyone and people can change careers.



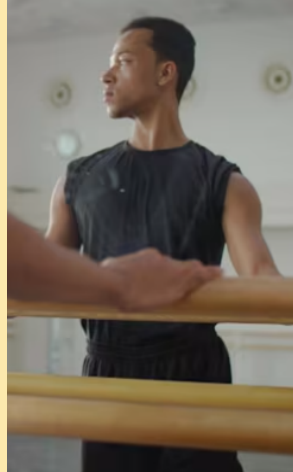

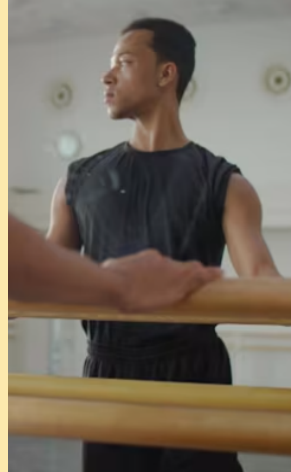

A stereotype is when we assume something about someone without knowing them.



Stereotypes are wrong and can be harmful because they might stop people following their dreams.

interested in.

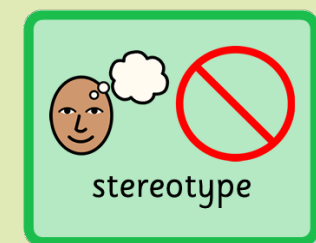
People can have more than one job in

and later become a teacher.



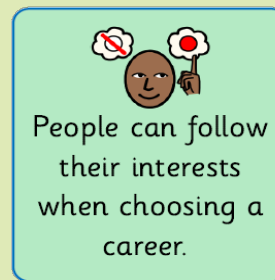
